Newaygo Natural Areas Stewardship Worker

The Michigan Nature Association (MNA), a statewide land conservancy, is seeking to hire two seasonal employees to conduct grant-funded stewardship work at our Newaygo Prairie Nature Sanctuary and assist with trail maintenance at our Dowagiac Woods Nature Sanctuary. Hourly Short-term Position: The employee shall be eligible to conduct short-term work between the dates

of November 1, 2023 and May 1, 2024. The employee shall not work in excess of 38 hours in any calendar week and shall not work in excess of 550 hours over

the entirety of this position.

Compensation: \$16.00 per hour + mileage reimbursement at the rate of \$0.54 per mile for

each day that the employee drives their personal vehicle and works onsite in excess of 4 hours on that day (mileage based on distance from their home).

Service Area: The position is based at MNA's Newaygo County Nature Sanctuary in Brooks

Township, Newaygo County, Michigan. The position will also assist with trail construction at MNA's Dowagiac Woods Nature Sanctuary in Cass County.

Reports to: Western Lower Peninsula Conservation Coordinator

Duties:

- Working independently or with MNA staff to complete savanna restoration work at Newaygo Prairie, including
 practices such as tree girdling, hack and squirt management, and cut stump treatment methods of invasive trees
 and shrubs and will Conduct brush pile burning activities
- Working independently or with MNA staff to assist with the demolition, replacement, and construction of the boardwalk trail system at Dowagiac Woods
- Submit bi-weekly timesheets, travel records, and activity progress reports
- Work with volunteers and lead volunteer work days
- Maintain stewardship equipment provided by MNA

Qualifications:

- Must be physically capable of walking long distances in adverse terrain, capable of lifting 50 lbs., and be willing to work in adverse weather conditions to complete work.
- Knowledge of the ecology, flora, and fauna of the Western Lower Peninsula
- Familiarity with the maintenance and repair of stewardship equipment
- Preference will be given to applicants possessing a Michigan pesticide applicator license
